“THEATRE” Project THEATRE AS EMPOWERMENT METHODOLOGY FOR iVET

The Leonardo da Vinci TOI - Theatre project aims at favouring the diffusion of a theatrical approach to learning as connection with vocational, key and digital skills and competences fitting the needs of young learners (digital native). The research phase

The aim of first THEATRE project phase is to analyse and prepare the backgrounds to make the good practice fully transferable and fitting different contexts, needs and learners.

In order to reach this general aim, some operating and intermediate objectives have been set up:

- Comparison between the good practice and local context
- Benchmarking among the good practice to be transferred and other practices and approaches used in partners' and EU contexts
- Define common milestones and results to be achieved

The good practice

The reasons for drop out phenomenon in iVET are closely linked to the individual sphere, however they follow certain patterns that could be addressed setting up approaches combining individual and group activities. Extracurricular activities should be regarded as a fundamental tool to decrease the risk of drop out and alienation to the education / training, especially among the younger learners, to increase the motivation and support the vocational and personal learning process. According to this background, Centro Studi Opera Don Calabria has been organizing, since many years, theatrical activities dedicated to students attending vocational training courses. The experience is realised by the theatrical workshop “Cosquillas” made up of professional educators, pedagogues and experts in the art field also characterized by many years of experience in the field of social disadvantage. Using an holistic approach taking care of the whole person, the Cosquillas approach and methodologies emphasize real capabilities of the participants in order to encourage full growth of the person. Expressive and communicative activities fostered by the Cosquillas approach usually lead to significant reduction in social, emotional uneasiness feelings. The theatrical approach seems to be well accepted by the participants, thanks to a playful methodology that contributes in creating favorable condition for the achievement of the educational objectives, such as: self-development, increase social integration; develop perceptual abilities, motor, cognitive and social skills; expand the ‘know-how’ and ‘to be’ of each participant; promote autonomy; promote the socialization of communication.
